<sup>1</sup> **Solemnity of All Saints**, November 1<sup>st</sup> - If Mass is celebrated on the evening of Sunday, October 31<sup>st</sup> it is that of the Solemnity of All Saints, the attendance at which fulfills the Sunday obligation.

<sup>1</sup> While the ritual Mass for marriage is forbidden on this day, the Mass of the day with the nuptial blessing may be celebrated and one of the readings from the texts for marriage may be chosen.

<sup>1</sup> **Day of Penance and Prayer:** Day of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion, and of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life. The Mass "For Peace and Justice" in Various Needs and Occasions no. 22 of the Sacramentary should be celebrated with violet vestments (GIRM 373).

<sup>1</sup> For your planning information, sunset on Holy Saturday will occur at 7:24 pm Pacific Daylight Time. Since liturgical directives in the *Missale Romanum* indicate the **entire Vigil should take place after nightfall, in darkness, the Vigil is to be scheduled no earlier than 8:00 pm.**

<sup>1</sup> The second reading and Gospel from the **Seventh Sunday of Easter** may be read on the **Sixth Sunday of Easter**.

**Funeral Masses:** The Funeral Mass may be celebrated on any day except solemnities that are days of obligation, Holy Thursday, the Easter Triduum and the Sundays during the seasons of Advent, Lent and Easter (GIRM 380).
